- Scholastic abilities
- Academic record

- Test scores
- Essays
- Community and school contributions
- High school's recommendation

To enter your child, access the <u>BMC Scholarship Program online entry form</u> and complete the application by **February 28, 2014**. (You may also want to print a copy of the "Submission Confirmation" for your records.) Winners will be notified by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation in April 2015.

## **Scholarship Program Criteria**

- An entry form must be submitted by February 28, 2014 to be considered for the program.
- Students must take the PSAT/NMSQT in the fall of 2013.
- Students must enter college in the fall of 2015.
- The National Merit Scholarship Corporation handles all aspects of winner selection and award administration.
- Only children of U.S.-based employees are eligible.
